**ANNOUNCEMENTS/COMMUNICATIONS** – Treasurer Beegle reported that the White Lake Fire Authority met on May 9. They received a good audit report for fiscal year ending 2017. The ISO rating that is conducted every five years did not change but could be increased if a training room were available, and if aging equipment were replaced. The WLFA will be undertaking a

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lighting enhancement to replace bulbs with LED and adding a generator to Fire Station #2. Supervisor Jeske stated that SPLKA will be adding a sidewalk from the workshop to the oil house removing any stairs for handicap accessibility. Supervisor Jeske also stated that River Road is expected to be open by Friday this week. Clerk Rillema received the PINS Stats for April and will place on file. There were 13 property checks, 49 calls for service, 10 traffic stops, 16 reports and 1 traffic crash.
