NOTICE FRUITLAND TOWNSHIP CEMETERY

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that all summer decorations from grave sites within the Fruitland Township Cemetery, located at the intersection of Bard and Lorenson Roads, must be removed no later than October 6, 2023 for fall maintenance, according to Fruitland Township Regulatory Ordinance R7 Section 7.05. Decorations and plants that are not removed will be removed by the Fruitland Township maintenance personnel. Winter decorations of burial spaces shall be placed after November 30, 2023 and removed no later than April 15, 2024 for spring maintenance.
