ELECTION ANNOUNCEMENTS

- Starting today, new voters must register **IN PERSON** at their Clerk's office if planning to vote in the November 7, 2023 election.
- Some voters may have received a new Voter ID Card. A small number of voters were changed from Precinct 1 to Precinct 2 to better reflect the County Commissioner division line that runs down Duck Lake Road in Fruitland Township.
- Whitehall District Schools will have a bond proposal for the November 7, 2023 election. This will be the only question on the ballot for Fruitland Township.
- Absent Voter Ballots are available. Please contact the Clerk's office to determine the best way to receive your ballot if you have not requested one already.
- The Public Accuracy Test for the November 7, 2023 Special Election will be held on Thursday, November 2, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. in the Fruitland Township Hall, this test is conducted to determine that the program and the computer being used to tabulate the results of the election, counts the votes in the manner prescribed by the law.
- The Fruitland Township Hall will be open Saturday, November 4, 2023 from 8am – 4pm for voter registration and issuing absentee ballots only.

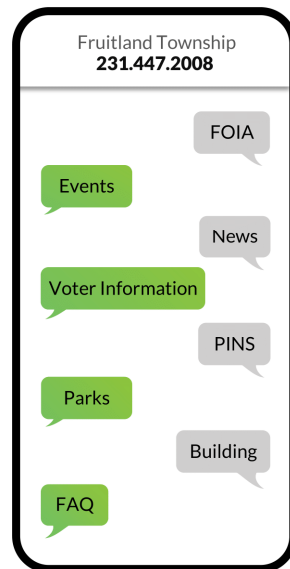

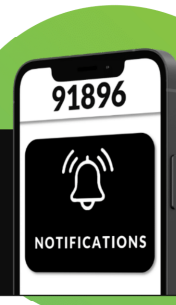
