FRUITLAND AND LAKETON TOWNSHIPS CITIZEN'S ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR SCENIC DRIVE NON-MOTORIZED PATH FUNDRAISING

MPART PFAS COMMUNITY MEETING – FRUITLAND TOWNSHIP

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 30, 2023

The Michigan PFAS Action Response Team (MPART) will host a public meeting about the per- and polyfluoroalkyl substance (PFAS) investigation at/near Fruitland Township Landfill. A MPART representative will share information about MPART and an overview of PFAS, which are a large group of human-made substances used in manufacturing, firefighting, and consumer products.

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services will provide information about possible health effects related to PFAS exposure. A representative from the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy will provide an overview of PFAS investigation at/near Fruitland Township Landfill, PFAS data gathered, and next steps. Community members will have the opportunity to ask questions after the presentations.
