Activities Beneficial to Bees

PLANT ORGANIC NATIVE AND POLLINATOR PLANTS WITH ORGANIC SOIL

Plant a variety of colorful flowering plants that are attractive to bees and bloom at different times. Check the label and avoid using neonic-treated seedlings and seeds.

AVOID USING PESTICIDES

Pesticides are an important contributor to the decline of pollinators because of their acute and chronic effects. Pesticide-free spaces are important for pollinator health and the environment.

GO ORGANIC

There are many reasons to plant an organic garden and eat organic food, including protecting pollinators. Our food buying decisions can either support or reject hazardous agricultural practices and protection of pollinators, as well as contributing to the working conditions for farmers.
